The Insurance Brokers (Registration) Act 1977 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1978

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 30(3) of the Insurance Brokers (Registration) Act 1977(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Insurance Brokers (Registration) Act 1977 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1978.
- 2. The following provisions of the Insurance Brokers (Registration) Act 1977 shall come into operation on 20th October 1978, that is to say:—

Section 4	(list of bodies corporate carrying on business as insurance brokers)
Section 5	(appeals against refusal to register or enrol)
Section 9	(publication of register and list)

Section 15	(erasure from register and list for crime, unprofessional conduct, etc.)
Section 16	(restoration of names erased as result of disciplinary cases, etc.)
Section 17	(erasure from register and list on grounds of fraud or error)
Section 18	(appeals in disciplinary and other cases)
Section 19 (1) to (3)	(procedure of Disciplinary Committee)
Section 20	(assessors to Disciplinary Committee)

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into force on 20th October 1978 the provisions of the Insurance Brokers (Registration) Act 1977 that relate to the opening and maintenance of the register and list and its publication, erasure therefrom, restoration of names thereto, disciplinary cases and appeals.

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
