The Social Security (Categorisation of Earners) Amendment **Regulations 1978**

Made 10th October 1978 Laid before Parliament 13th October 1978 Coming into Operation 3rd November 1978

The Secretary of State for Social Services in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 2(2)(a) of the Social Security Act 1975(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, after considering the report of the National Insurance Advisory Committee on the draft submitted to them in accordance with section 139 of that Act, hereby makes the following regulations:-

Citation, interpretation and commencement

1. These regulations which may be cited as the Social Security (Categorisation of Earners) Amendment Regulations 1978 shall be read as one with the Social Security (Categorisation of Earners) Regulations 1975(b) as amended(c) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") and shall come into operation on 3rd November 1978.

Substitution for paragraph 9 in column (A) in Part III of Schedule 1 to the principal regulations

- 2. For paragraph 9 in column (A) in Part III of Schedule 1 to the principal regulations there shall be substituted the following paragraph-
 - "9. Employment for the purpose of any election or referendum authorised by Act of Parliament-
 - (a) as a returning officer or acting returning officer; or
 - (b) as a Chief Counting Officer or counting officer; or
 - (c) of any person by any officer referred to in (a) or (b) above."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Social Security (Categorisation of Earners) Regulations 1975. They substitute a new provision which disregards for contribution purposes employment as a returning officer or counting officer or of persons appointed by such officers for the purpose of any election or referendum authorised by Act of Parliament.

The report of the National Insurance Advisory Committee on the draft of these Regulations dated 20th September 1978 is contained in Command Paper (Cmnd. 7393) published by Her Majesty's Stationery Office.
