The Milk (Great Britain) (Amendment) (No. 3)

Order 1978

Made - - - - 19th October 1978
Laid before Parliament 20th October 1978
Coming into Operation 5th November 1978

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State, acting jointly in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 6 (continued in force by the Milk (Extension of Period of Control of Maximum Prices) Orders 1969(a) and 1974(b)) and section 7 of the Emergency Laws (Re-enactments and Repeals) Act 1964(c) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Milk (Great Britain) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 1978, and shall come into operation on 5th November 1978.

Amendment of the principal order

2. The Milk (Great Britain) Order 1977(d) as amended(e) shall be further amended by substituting for Schedules 1, 2 and 3 thereto respectively Schedules 1, 2 and 3 to this order.

Revocation

3. The Milk (Great Britain) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1978(e) is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE 1

MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES OF MILK IN ENGLAND AND WALES

1. Subject to the provisions of this Schedule, the maximum price of milk on a sale by retail in England and Wales shall be a price in accordance with the following table:—

Milk	Maximum Price (Rate per Pint)
Channel Islands milk	p 15½
South Devon milk	15½
Untreated Milk Farm Bottled	14½
Ultra Heat Treated milk	14
Sterilised milk	14
Homogenised milk	14
Untreated milk	13½
Pasteurised milk	13½
Milk, other than the above mentioned	13½

2. A reasonable charge may be made by the seller in addition to the appropriate maximum price specified in the above table for milk sold by him as Kosher milk or Kedassia milk if—

- (a) such milk is sold in a container distinctly labelled “Kosher” or “Kedassia”, as the case may be; and
- (b) such milk has been prepared for consumption in accordance with the appropriate Jewish practice relating thereto.

SCHEDULE 2

Article 3(1)(b)

MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES OF MILK IN SCOTLAND

1. Subject to the provisions of this Schedule, the maximum price of milk on a sale by retail in Scotland, excluding the islands other than the islands of Arran, Bute, Coll, Gigha, Islay and The Great Cumbrae and those comprising the Islands Area of Orkney, shall be a price in accordance with the following table:—

Channel Islands milk	p 14½	p 15½
South Devon milk	14½	15½
Premium milk	13½	14½
Ultra Heat Treated milk	13	14

Homogenised milk	13	14
Standard milk	12½	13½
Pasteurised milk	12½	13½
Milk, other than the above mentioned	12½	13½

2. A reasonable charge may be made by the seller in addition to the appropriate maximum price specified in the above table for milk sold by him as Kosher milk or Kedassia milk if—

- (a) such milk is sold in a container distinctly labelled “Kosher” or “Kedassia”, as the case may be; and
- (b) such milk has been prepared for consumption in accordance with the appropriate Jewish practice relating thereto.

SCHEDULE 3

MAXIMUM PRICES OF RAW MILK ON SALE FOR HEAT TREATMENT AND RESALE

(c) at a dairy situated in Scotland excluding the islands other than the islands of Arran, Bute, Coll, Gigha, Islay and The Great Cumbrae and those comprising the Islands Area of Orkney	12.083	13.211

1. In the case of Channel Islands or South Devon milk, a charge at the rate of 2.904p per litre for the months April to September inclusive, and a charge at the rate of 3.124p per litre for the months October to March inclusive, may be made in addition to the appropriate maximum price specified in the above table.

2. Where the milk is sold on terms which are less or more favourable to the purchaser than normal delivery terms the appropriate maximum price shall have effect subject to a reduction or increase respectively of such amount as is appropriate in the circumstances.

3. A reasonable additional charge may be made by the seller in respect of any milk which is so treated by the purchaser as to become homogenised milk.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This amending Order, which comes into operation on 5th November 1978—

- (a) increases by 1p per pint the maximum retail prices of milk on sales in England and Wales, with effect from 5th November 1978;
- (b) increases, by various amounts in different areas (as shown in Schedule 3), the maximum prices for the sale in Great Britain of raw milk for heat treatment, with effect from 1st December 1978;
- (c) increases by 1p per pint the maximum retail prices of milk on sales in Scotland, with effect from 3rd December 1978.
