## **RENTS AND RENTCHARGES**

## The Rentcharges Act 1977 (Commencement) Order 1978

Made - - - 9th January 1978

The Secretary of State for the Environment (as respects England) and the Secretary of State for Wales (as respects Wales) in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 18(2) of the Rentcharges Act 1977(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following order:—

- 1. This order may be cited as the Rentcharges Act 1977 (Commencement) Order 1978.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The provisions of the Rentcharges Act 1977, so far as they are not already in operation, shall come into force on 1st February 1978.
