SHERIFF COURT, SCOTLAND

Act of Sederunt (Commissary Business) (Amendment) 1978

<i>Made</i> - - - -	20th October 1978
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	30th October 1978
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	21st November 1978

The Lords of Council and Session, under and by virtue of the powers conferred on them by section 54 of the Sheriff Courts (Scotland) Act 1876(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, do hereby enact and declare as follows:—

1.—(1) This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Commissary Business) (Amendment) 1978, and shall come into operation on 21st November 1978.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) applies to the interpretation of this Act of Sederunt as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. In column 2 of the Schedule of the Act of Sederunt (Commissary Business) 1975(c) (places where commissary business may be conducted in the commissariat of the sheriffdom), opposite the entry relating to the Sheriffdom of Grampian, Highlands and Islands specified in column 1 of that Schedule there is substituted—

(a) for the word “Nairn” the word “Peterhead”; and

(b) for the words “Kirkwall and Lerwick” the words “and Kirkwall”.

And the Lords appoint this Act of Sederunt to be inserted in the Books of Sederunt.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Act of Sederunt.)

This Act of Sederunt makes certain minor amendments in relation to the Sheriff Courts in which commissary business may be conducted by providing that such business may be conducted at Peterhead Sheriff Court and will no longer be conducted at Nairn and Lerwick Sheriff Courts.
