The Sea Fishing (Specified Foreign Boats) Licensing (No. 3) Order 1977 (Variation) Order 1978

Made -16th November 1978 Laid before Parliament 20th November 1978 Coming into Operation 21st November 1978

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with the sea fishing industry in Scotland and Northern Ireland and the Secretary of State for Wales, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 4 and 20(1) of the Sea Fish (Conservation) Act 1967(a) (as the former section is amended by section 3 of the Fishery Limits Act 1976(b)) and now vested in them by Article 2(3) of the Transfer of Functions (Wales) (No. 1) Order 1978(c), and of all their other enabling powers, hereby make the following order:-

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Sea Fishing (Specified Foreign Boats) Licensing (No. 3) Order 1977 (Variation) Order 1978, and shall come into operation on 21st November 1978.

Interpretation

- 2.—(1) In this order, "the principal order" means the Sea Fishing (Specified Foreign Boats) Licensing (No. 3) Order 1977(d), as varied(e).
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(f) applies for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Variation of principal order

- 3.—(1) The principal order shall be varied in accordance with the following paragraphs of this Article.
 - (2) In Schedule 1 thereto—
 - (a) the following description shall be substituted for the description in Column 2, opposite the reference in Column 1 to "part of VIA":-

"That part of ICES area VIA which is bounded by a line beginning at a point on the north coast of Scotland in 4°00' west longitude; thence due north to 60°30′ north latitude; thence due west to 5°00′ west longitude; thence due south to 60°00′ north latitude; thence due west to 12°00' west longitude; thence due

south to 56°30′ north latitude; thence due east to the coast of Scotland; thence in a northerly direction along the west coast of Scotland to the point of beginning.";

(b) by the insertion in Column 1, under the reference to "VIB", of a reference to "part of VIB", and by the insertion in Column 2 opposite that reference of the following description:—

"That part of ICES area VIB which lies north of 56°30' north latitude."; and

(c) by the insertion in Column 1, under the reference to "VII", of a reference to "part of VII", and by the insertion in Column 2 opposite that reference of the following description:—

"All of ICES area VII, except that part which lies both north of 50°30′ north latitude and east of 12°00′ west longitude.".

(3) The following Schedule shall be substituted for Schedule 2 thereto:—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order further varies the Sea Fishing (Specified Foreign Boats) Licensing (No. 3) Order 1977 by bringing fishing boats registered in Sweden and the Faroe Islands within its terms, and altering the arrangements in relation to Spanish vessels. As a result, such vessels will, under the authority of licences granted by the European Economic Community, be entitled to fish in those ICES areas specified in column 2 of the new Schedule 2 to the 1977 Order for the species of fish specified in column 3 of that Schedule.

The Order also makes adjustments to Schedule 1 to the 1977 Order in respect of the descriptions of the ICES areas to which it applies.
