The Heathrow Airport—London Noise Insulation Grants (Second Amendment) Scheme 1978

Whereas it appears to the Secretary of State that dwellings near Heathrow Airport—London, being a designated aerodrome within the meaning of section 29 of the Civil Aviation Act 1971(a), require further protection from noise and vibration attributable to the use of the aerodrome than can be given by virtue of that section and for that purpose the Heathrow Airport—London Noise Insulation Grants Scheme 1975(b) requires to be further varied:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 29A of the Civil Aviation Act 1971, as inserted in that Act by section 25(1) of and Schedule 5 to the Airports Authority Act 1975(c) and as amended by paragraph 6(8) of Schedule 1 to the Civil Aviation Act 1978(d), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf and after consultation with the British Airports Authority (being the relevant manager for the purposes of the said section 29A), hereby makes the following Scheme:—

- 1. This Scheme may be cited as the Heathrow Airport—London Noise Insulation Grants (Second Amendment) Scheme 1978 and shall come into operation on 31st December 1978.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(e) shall apply for the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The Heathrow Airport—London Noise Insulation Grants Scheme 1975, as varied(f), shall be further varied by the substitution in Article 7(1)(f) of "1st July 1979" for "1st January 1979".
