**ACQUISITION OF LAND**

**The Home Loss Payments (Scotland) Order 1978**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>2nd March 1978</i>
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	<i>10th March 1978</i>
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>1st April 1978</i>

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 28(2) of the Land Compensation (Scotland) Act 1973(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Home Loss Payments (Scotland) Order 1978 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1978.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. In Section 28(1) of the Land Compensation (Scotland) Act 1973 for the word “six” there shall be substituted the words “two and three quarters”.

This Order amends the multiplier used in determining the amounts of home loss payments under section 28 of the Land Compensation (Scotland) Act 1973. Its effect will be broadly to maintain the levels of payments after the 1978 revaluation becomes effective.
