- 1. This order may be cited as the Criminal Law Act 1977 (Commencement No. 6) (Scotland) Order 1978.

- 3. The provisions of the Criminal Law Act 1977 specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this order (which relate to the matters specified in column 2 thereof) shall come into force on 17th July 1978.
