1979 No. 136**CUSTOMS AND EXCISE****The Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment)
Order 1979***Made* - - - - - 12th February 1979*Coming into Operation* 12th February 1979

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on 12th February 1979.

2. The Export of Goods (Control) Order 1978(c) shall be amended by inserting in the entry in Group 3C of Part II of Schedule 1 relating to frequency changers “and parts, components and sub-assemblies therefor” after “600-2000Hz”.
