

1979 No. 1390 (S. 113)**LEGAL AID AND ADVICE, SCOTLAND****The Legal Advice and Assistance (Scotland)
(Financial Conditions) (No. 3) Regulations 1979***Made* - - - - - 25th October 1979*Laid before Parliament* - - - 2nd November 1979*Coming into Operation in accordance with Regulation 1—(1)*

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 15 of the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1967(a) and sections 4 and 11 of the Legal Advice and Assistance Act 1972(b) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Legal Advice and Assistance (Scotland) (Financial Conditions) (No. 3) Regulations 1979 and shall come into operation on the day on which the Legal Advice and Assistance (Scotland) (Financial Conditions) No. 4 Regulations(c) come into operation.

(2) In these regulations, “the Act” means the Legal Advice and Assistance Act 1972, and “the 1979 Regulations” mean the Legal Advice and Assistance (Scotland) (Financial Conditions) (No. 1) Regulations 1979(d).

2.—(1) For the sum of £35 specified in section 4(2) of the Act as amended by the 1979 Regulations there shall be substituted the sum of £40.

(2) For the sums specified in Schedule 1 to the Act as amended by the 1979 Regulations there shall be substituted the following:—

“1. Exceeding £40 but not exceeding £50 a week	£5
2. Exceeding £50 but not exceeding £53 a week	£9
3. Exceeding £53 but not exceeding £56 a week	£13
4. Exceeding £56 but not exceeding £59 a week	£17
5. Exceeding £59 but not exceeding £62 a week	£21
6. Exceeding £62 but not exceeding £65 a week	£25
7. Exceeding £65 but not exceeding £68 a week	£29
8. Exceeding £68 but not exceeding £71 a week	£33
9. Exceeding £71 but not exceeding £74 a week	£37

10. Exceeding £74 but not exceeding £77 a week	£41
11. Exceeding £77 but not exceeding £80 a week	£45
12. Exceeding £80 but not exceeding £85 a week	£49"

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations increase from £35 to £40 the weekly disposable income above which a person in receipt of legal advice and assistance is required to pay a contribution and revise the scale of contributions to be paid where the weekly disposable income exceeds £40 but does not exceed £85.
