## Act of Sederunt (Commissary Business) (Amendment) 1979

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>1st November 1979</i>
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	<i>9th November 1979</i>
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>3rd December 1979</i>

The Lords of Council and Session under and by virtue of the powers conferred on them by section 54 of the Sheriff Courts (Scotland) Act 1876<sup>(a)</sup> and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, do hereby enact and declare as follows:—

*Commencement and citation*

1. This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Commissary Business) (Amendment) 1979 and shall come into operation on 3rd December, 1979.

*Cessation of commissary business at Dunoon*

2. In column 2 of the Schedule of the Act of Sederunt (Commissary Business) 1975<sup>(b)</sup> (places where commissary business may be conducted in the commissariat of the sheriffdom), opposite the entry relating to the Sheriffdom of North Strathclyde specified in column 1 of that schedule the word "Dunoon" shall be omitted.

And the Lords appoint this Act of Sederunt to be inserted in the Books of Sederunt.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Act of Sederunt.)*

This Act of Sederunt makes an amendment in relation to the Sheriff Courts in which commissary business may be conducted by providing that such business will no longer be conducted at Dunoon Sheriff Court.
