CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

The Customs Duties (ECSC) Anti-Dumping (Amendment) Order 1979

Made -15th February 1979

Laid before the House

of Commons -16th February 1979

17th February 1979 Coming into Operation

The Treasury, by virtue of the powers conferred on them by section 5(1) and (3) of the European Communities Act 1972(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, on the recommendation of the Secretary of State, hereby makes the following Order:-

Citation, operation, interpretation

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (ECSC) Anti-Dumping (Amendment) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on 17th February 1979.
 - (2) In this Order-
 - "the principal Orders" means the Customs Duties (ECSC) Anti-Dumping (No. 15) Order 1978(b) and the Customs Duties (ECSC) Anti-Dumping (No. 16) Order 1978(c).
 - "the Commissioners" means the Commissioners of Customs and Excise.
- (3) This Order is made pursuant to Commission Recommendation 165/79/ECSC(d) requiring the suspension of the duties imposed by the principal Orders in relation to goods originating in Bulgaria.

Cessation of charge of duty

- 2.—(1) The principal Orders shall be amended in accordance with paragraph (2) below.
- (2) On and after the coming into operation of this Order, no duty of customs shall be charged under the principal Orders on the importation into the United Kingdom of goods originating in Bulgaria.

Repayment of duty

3. Any duty paid under the principal Orders before the coming into operation of this Order in respect of goods originating in Bulgaria imported

into the United Kingdom on or after 31st January 1979 shall, on application being made by the importer to the Commissioners, be repaid by the Commissioners.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order provides that no anti-dumping duty shall be charged after the coming into operation of this Order on imports of certain iron and steel products originating in Bulgaria where such duty was imposed by the Customs Duties (ECSC) Anti-Dumping (No. 15) Order 1978 or the Customs Duties (ECSC) Anti-Dumping (No. 16) Order 1978.

This Order also provides that any duty paid under the No. 15 Order or the No. 16 Order in respect of such goods imported into the United Kingdom on or after 31st January 1979 shall be repaid.

The United Kingdom is under a Community obligation by virtue of the Recommendation referred to in the Order to suspend the duties charged by the Orders referred to above.
