# The Police Cadets (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1979

Made	14th December 1979
Laid before Parliament	3rd January 1980
Coming into Operation	24th January 1980

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 27 of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consulting the Police Council for the United Kingdom in accordance with section 4(4) of the Police Act 1969(b), I hereby make the following regulations:—

#### Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Police Cadets (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1979.

### Interpretation

2. In these regulations any reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Police Cadets (Scotland) Regulations 1968(c).

## Operation and effect

- 3. These regulations shall come into operation on 24th January 1980 and shall have effect:—
  - (a) for the purposes of regulation 4, as from 1st September 1979;
  - (b) for the purposes of regulation 5, as from 24th January 1980.

### Pay

4. For the Table in Schedule 1 to the principal regulations (which contains scales of pay) there shall be substituted the following Table:—

Charges for board and lodging

5. In Schedule 2 to the principal regulations (which relates to charges for board and lodging), for the sum "£228" there shall be substituted the sum "£275".

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Police Cadets (Scotland) Regulations 1968.

Regulation 4 increases the pay of police cadets as from 1st September 1979 (retrospective effect is authorised by section 27(2) of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967).

Regulation 5 increases, from 24th January 1980, the charges payable by cadets for board and lodging provided by police authorities.
