**The Royal Air Force Terms of Service (Amendment)
Regulations 1979**

Made - - - - 27th February 1979

Laid before Parliament 5th March 1979

Coming into Operation 5th April 1979

The Defence Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 2 of the Armed Forces Act 1966(a) and section 2 of the Armed Forces Act 1976(b) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation, Commencement and Interpretation

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Royal Air Force Terms of Service (Amendment) Regulations 1979, and shall come into force on 5th April 1979.

(2) In these Regulations “the Principal Regulations” means the Royal Air Force Terms of Service Regulations 1977(c).

Amendments to the Principal Regulations

2. Paragraph (2) and (3) of Regulation 9 of the Principal Regulations are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Royal Air Force Terms of Service Regulations 1977 by revoking Regulations 9(2) and 9(3) thereof. The effect is to remove the requirement that a person shall have completed 4 years service before giving notice under Regulation 9(1) to extend his term of service to one exceeding 15 years.
