BRITISH NATIONALITY

The British Nationality (Amendment) Regulations 1979

5th March 1979 Made -Coming into Operation 4th April 1979

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 29(1) of the British Nationality Act 1948(a), as extended and amended by section 4(7) of the Cyprus Act 1960(b), section 3(2) of the British Nationality Act 1964(c), section 6(2) of the British Nationality (No. 2) Act 1964(d) and section 5(2) of the British Nationality Act 1965(e), I hereby make with the consent of the Treasury the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the British Nationality (Amendment) Regulations 1979 and shall come into operation on 4th April 1979.
- 2. In these Regulations any reference to the principal Regulations is a reference to the British Nationality Regulations 1975(f).
- 3. In Regulation 28(2) of the principal Regulations (which relates to the fee payable in respect of a wife's registration or naturalisation), for the word "£35" there shall be substituted the word "£37.50".
- 4. For Schedule 19 to the principal Regulations (which relates to the fees which may be taken) there shall be substituted the Schedule set out in the Appendix to these Regulations.

In Scotland, if the application or declaration is witnessed or the oath administered by a sheriff principal or sheriff, to the sheriff clerk or to any of his deputes, and, if by a notary public, to the notary public."

These Regulations increase certain fees payable under the British Nationality Regulations 1975 in respect of the conferment on adults of citizenship of the United Kingdom and Colonies or British subject status.
