## FISHERY LIMITS

**The Fishing Boats (Faroe Islands) Designation Order 1979**

<i>Made</i> - - - -	<i>7th March 1979</i>
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	<i>9th March 1979</i>
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>10th March 1979</i>

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with sea fishing in Scotland and Northern Ireland and the Secretary of State for Wales, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(1) of the Fishery Limits Act 1976(a), and now vested in them(b) and of all their other enabling powers, hereby make the following order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This order may be cited as the Fishing Boats (Faroe Islands) Designation Order 1979, and shall come into operation on 10th March 1979.

*Interpretation*

2. In this order—

“the Act” means the Fishery Limits Act 1976;

“ICES areas” means those statistical areas of the International Council for the Exploration of the Sea(c) which are referred to by their short names in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this order and are described in column 2 of that Schedule opposite the reference to their short names, but excluding any part of those areas which is within 12 miles from the baselines from which the breadth of the territorial sea adjacent to the United Kingdom, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man is measured, or which is outside British fishery limits.

*Access to British fisheries*

3.—(1) The Faroe Islands are hereby designated for the purposes of section 2(1) of the Act.

(2) In relation to the Faroe Islands, there are hereby designated the ICES areas specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 to this order (hereinafter called “the designated areas”).

(3) The descriptions of sea fish for which fishing boats registered in the Faroe Islands may fish in any of the designated areas shall be those specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 to this order, opposite the reference to that area.

4. This order shall expire on 31st March 1979.

IV	<p>The waters bounded by a line beginning at a point on the coast of Norway in 62° 00' north latitude; thence due west to 4° 00' west longitude; thence due south to the coast of Scotland; thence in an easterly and southerly direction along the coasts of Scotland and England to a point in 51° 00' north latitude; thence due east to the coast of France; thence in a north-easterly direction along the coasts of France, Belgium, the Netherlands and the Federal Republic of Germany to the western terminus of its boundary with Denmark; thence along the west coast of Jutland to Thyboren; thence in a southerly and easterly direction along the south coast of the Limfjord to Egensekloster Point; thence across the eastern entrance of the Limfjord to Hals; thence in a westerly direction along the north coast of the Limfjord to the southern-most point of Agger Tange; thence in a northerly direction along the west coast of Jutland to a point in 57° 00' north latitude; thence due west to 8° 00' east longitude; thence due north to 57° 30' north latitude; thence due west to 7° 00' east longitude; thence due north to the coast of Norway; thence in a north-westerly direction along the coast of Norway to the point of beginning.</p>		
VI	<p>The waters bounded by a line beginning at a point on the north coast of Scotland in 4° 00' west longitude; thence due north to 60° 30' north latitude; thence due west to 5° 00' west longitude; thence due south to 60° 00' north latitude; thence due west to 18° 00' west longitude; thence due south to 54° 30' north latitude; thence due east to the coast of the Republic of Ireland; thence in a northerly and easterly direction along the coasts of the Republic of Ireland and of Northern Ireland to a point on the east coast of Northern Ireland in 55° 00' north latitude; thence due east to the coast of Scotland; thence in a northerly direction along the west coast of Scotland to the point of beginning.</p>		
Part of VIA	<p>That part of ICES areas VIA which is bounded by a line beginning at a point on the north coast of Scotland in 4° 00' west longitude; thence due north to 60° 30' north latitude; thence due west to 5° 00' west longitude; thence due south to 60° 00' north latitude; thence due west to 12° 00' west longitude; thence due south to 56° 30' north latitude; thence due east to the coast of Scotland; thence in a northerly direction along the west coast of Scotland to the point of beginning.</p>

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order designates the Faroe Islands as a country whose registered fishing boats may fish in the areas specified in the Order for the descriptions of sea fish indicated in relation to those areas. The Order is made as a result of a Regulation of the Council of the European Economic Community continuing the operation of a reciprocal agreement with the Faroe Islands, and it expires on 31st March 1979 in accordance with that Regulation.
