The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 1(4) of the Industry Act 1972(a), hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Special Development Area (Falmouth) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on 12th March 1979.

2.—(1) The employment office area of Falmouth is hereby designated as a special development area for the purposes of section 1 of the Industry Act 1972.

(2) Notwithstanding that by reason of paragraph (1) above the employment office area of Falmouth becomes a special development area, no grant at the rate of 22 per cent may be made under Part I of the Industry Act 1972 to any person towards expenditure incurred by him in providing an asset as part of, on or for use in qualifying premises in that area if the expenditure was defrayed before the date on which this Order comes into operation.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order upgrades the employment office area of Falmouth from development area to special development area.

The Order also contains a transitional provision whereby expenditure in the Falmouth employment office area will not be eligible for regional development grant on the basis of the new grading if the expenditure was defrayed before the Order comes into operation.
