CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

The Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 3) Order 1979

Made - - - - - 9th March 1979

Coming into Operation—

for all purposes other than those
of Article 2(b) - - - 12th March 1979

for the purposes of Article 2(b) 1st April 1979

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939(a) and now vested in him (b), hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 3) Order 1979 and shall come into operation:

for all purposes other than those of Article 2(b) on 12th March 1979;
for the purposes of Article 2(b) on 1st April 1979.

2. The Export of Goods (Control) Order 1978(c) shall be amended as follows:—

(a) in Group 2 of Part II of Schedule 1 there shall be included the following entry:

“Equipment specially designed for the manufacture or assembly of goods included in the entry relating to centrifuges in this Group.....A”

(b) in Article 1(2) ““United Kingdom” includes the Isle of Man” shall be deleted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order further amends the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1978 by including among the goods of which the export is controlled equipment specially designed for the manufacture or assembly of goods included in the entry relating to centrifuges in Group 2 of Part II of Schedule 1; by deleting the provision that the "United Kingdom" includes the Isle of Man, as that provision is now otiose.

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
