## The Misuse of Drugs (Amendment) Regulations 1979

In pursuance of sections 7, 10 and 31 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971(a) and after consultation with the Advisory Council on the Misuse of Drugs, I hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs (Amendment) Regulations 1979 and shall come into operation on 14th May 1979.

2. Schedule 2 to the Misuse of Drugs Regulations 1973(b), shall be amended by the insertion in paragraph 1 of that Schedule, after the word “Phenazocine”, of the word “Phencyclidine”.
