Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 1)
(Court Fees) 1979

Made - - - - 21st March 1979

Coming into Operation 1st May 1979

The Lords of Council and Session, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section 2 of the Courts of Law Fees (Scotland) Act 1895(a), and section 16 of the Administration of Justice (Scotland) Act 1933(b) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, do hereby, with the approval of the Treasury, enact and declare:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 1) (Court Fees) 1979 and shall come into operation on 1st May 1979.

Amendment of Court Fees

2. In Rule 346 of the Rules of Court(c), as amended by the Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 2) (Court Fees) 1978(d), for the table of fees is substituted the table of fees set out in the Schedule to this Act, and the fees so substituted shall be payable in respect of the matters to which they relate from the date this Act of Sederunt comes into operation.

Revocation

3. The Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 2) (Court Fees) 1978(d) is revoked.

And the Lords appoint this Act of Sederunt to be inserted in the Books of Sederunt.

A. SIGNETING

1. Signeting of any writ or summons, if attendance is necessary outwith the normal office hours **£10-00**

B. GENERAL DEPARTMENT

1. Appeal, Summons, or other writ or step by which any cause, or proceeding, other than consistorial, is originated, in either the Inner or Outer House—inclusive fee (to comprehend signeting in normal office hours) **£15-00**
2. Writ by which a consistorial cause is originated—inclusive fee (to comprehend signeting within normal office hours, and, if applicable, issue to the Pursuer of an Extract in terms of Item G7 (a) of this table, and to the Defender, if appropriate, a duplicate thereof) **£22-00**
3. Defences, Answers or other writ or step by which a party other than an originating party first makes appearance in a cause or proceeding—inclusive fee **£15-00**
4. Special Case—inclusive fee:
- (a) Where two parties only **£15-00**
- (b) For each additional party, subject to a maximum of £25 per case **£5-00**
5. Minute by either party for variation of an order in a consistorial cause **£2-00**
6. Letter of request to a foreign court... .. **£2-00**
7. Citation of each jury, to include outlays incurred in citing and counter-manding—payable on receipt of instructions for issue of precept ... **£10-00**

Note: Instructions to be received and precept to be issued not later than 14 days prior to the date fixed for the trial.
