Whereas a draft of this Order has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 17(2)(a) of the Prevention of Terrorism (Temporary Provisions) Act 1976(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Prevention of Terrorism (Temporary Provisions) Act 1976 (Continuance) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on 25th March 1979.
- 2. In this Order "the temporary provisions of the Act of 1976" means sections 1 to 13, 14 (except in so far as it relates to orders under subsection (2)(a) or (b) of section 17) and 17(2)(c) of the Prevention of Terrorism (Temporary Provisions) Act 1976 and Schedules 1 to 3 thereto.
- 3. The temporary provisions of the Act of 1976 shall continue in force for a period of twelve months beginning with 25th March 1979.
