Whereas a draft of this Order has been laid before Parliament and approved by Resolution of each House pursuant to section 5(1) of the Films Act 1970(a):

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State in exercise of powers conferred by the said section 5(1), and now vested in him(b), and after consulting with the Cinematograph Films Council, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Cinematograph Films (Limits of Levy) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1979.
2. Section 2(3)(b) of the Cinematograph Films Act 1957(c) shall have effect as if for the words “seven million” there were substituted the words “twelve million”.
3. The Cinematograph Films (Limits of Levy) Order 1975(d) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends section 2(3)(b) of the Cinematograph Films Act 1957 (which provides for the limits on the yield of levy on exhibitors of films) by increasing the maximum limit (as increased by the Order revoked by this Order) from £7,000,000 to £12,000,000.
