## ROAD TRAFFIC

**The International Carriage of Perishable Foodstuffs (Fees)  
Regulations 1979**

Made - - - - 29th March 1979

*\*To be laid before Parliament*

Coming into Operation 1st October 1979

The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of his powers under sections 3(1), 4(1) and 20 of the International Carriage of Perishable Foodstuffs Act 1976(a) and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Regulations:—

*Commencement and citation*

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st October 1979, and may be cited as the International Carriage of Perishable Foodstuffs (Fees) Regulations 1979.

*Interpretation*

2.—In these Regulations—

“the general Regulations” means the International Carriage of Perishable Foodstuffs Regulations 1979(b);

the expressions “examination”, “test” and “transport equipment” have the meanings respectively assigned to them by Regulation 2(1) of the general Regulations; and

the expressions “vehicle” and “type vehicle” have the meanings respectively assigned to them in section 4 of the International Carriage of Perishable Foodstuffs Act 1976.

*Fees payable in respect of tests, type approval and examinations of transport equipment*

3.—(1) The fees specified in Part I of the Schedule to these Regulations are hereby prescribed as the fees to be paid in connection with the test of a unit of transport equipment and the certification of a unit of transport equipment which has been tested.

(2) The fees specified in Part II of the said Schedule are hereby prescribed as the fees to be paid for and in connection with the test of a unit of transport equipment as a type vehicle, for the certification of a type vehicle and for the certification of a vehicle which a certifying officer is satisfied conforms with a type vehicle.

(3) The fees specified in Part III of the said Schedule are hereby prescribed as the fees to be paid in connection with the examination of a unit of transport equipment and the certification of a unit of transport equipment which has been examined.

*Fee payable for a certified copy of a certificate of compliance*

4. The fee of £5 is hereby prescribed as the fee to be paid for the issue of a certified copy of a certificate of compliance.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

For the purposes of the International Carriage of Perishable Foodstuffs Act 1976 (an Act to enable the United Kingdom to accede to the Agreement on the International Carriage of Perishable Foodstuffs and on the Special Equipment to be used for such Carriage (ATP), and for purposes connected therewith) these Regulations prescribe fees in respect of tests, type approval examinations and certification of transport equipment used or intended to be used for the international carriage of perishable foodstuffs, and for the issue of certified copies of certificates of compliance.
