The Northumbrian Water Authority Constitution (Amendment) Order 1979

The Secretary of State for the Environment and the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, acting jointly in the exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 2(4), 3(1) and (9), and 36(2) of the Water Act 1973(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order as follows, in the terms of a draft approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Northumbrian Water Authority Constitution (Amendment) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on the day following the day on which it is made.

Amendment of Northumbrian Water Authority Constitution Order 1973

- 2. The Northumbrian Water Authority Constitution Order 1973(b) is hereby amended as follows:—
 - (a) in article 4(1) (which specifies the total number of members to be appointed to the Northumbrian Water Authority) for the word "nineteen" there shall be substituted the word "twenty";
 - (b) in column (2) of Schedule 1 (Numbers of Members to be Appointed by Local Authorities), opposite the words from "Chester-le-Street" to "Wear Valley" in column (1), for the words "One between them" there shall be substituted the words "Two between them."

Transitional provision

3. Any person who is a member of the Northumbrian Water Authority on the day on which this order comes into operation shall hold office for the term for which he would have held office if this order had not been made.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

The Northumbrian Water Authority Constitution Order 1973 defined the constitution of the Northumbrian Water Authority, one of the ten regional water authorities established for England and Wales under the Water Act 1973, and provided that the Authority should consist of nineteen members, of whom five were to be appointed by county councils specified in the order and five by groups of district councils so specified.

This order amends the 1973 order so as to provide that the Northumbrian Water Authority shall consist of twenty members, of whom five are to be appointed by specified county councils and six by specified groups of district councils.

The terms of office of existing members of the Authority are not affected by this order. The member appointed to fill the place newly created by the order will come into office (subject to paragraph 4(3) of Schedule 3 to the Water Act 1973) on 1st June 1979 and will hold office for a term of four years.
