Breach of regulations

31. If any person contravenes or fails to comply with any requirement of these regulations (not being a requirement to give notice of an accident or a requirement to submit himself to medical treatment or examination) in respect of which no special penalty is provided, he shall for such offence be liable on summary conviction to a penalty not exceeding [^{F4}£200] or, where the offence consists of continuing any such contravention or failure after conviction thereof, [^{F4}£20] for each day on which it is so continued.
