- 1. This Order may be cited as the Merchant Shipping Act 1970 (Commencement No. 6) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on 1st August 1979.
- 2. The provisions of the Act specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order (which relate to the matters specified in the second column of that Schedule) shall come into operation on 1st August 1979.
