**The Protection of Seed Crops (North Essex)
Order 1968 (Variation) Order 1979**

Made 23rd July 1979

Coming into Operation 3rd September 1979

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 33(3)(a) and (b) of the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, after consultation with the persons responsible for the arrangements made for locating crops of seeds of the plants protected by the Protection of Seed Crops (North Essex) Order 1968(b) so as to isolate them from crops or plants which might cause injurious cross-pollination, and with persons representative of such other interests as appear to him to be concerned, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation and Commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Protection of Seed Crops (North Essex) Order 1968 (Variation) Order 1979, and shall come into operation on 3rd September 1979.

Variation of Principal Order

2. Article 3 of the Protection of Seed Crops (North Essex) Order 1968 is hereby varied as follows:—

(a) 1964 c.14; to which there are no amendments relevant to this order.
(b) S.I. 1968/207.

For the words—

“eastwards along the A414 road from the point where that road crosses the county boundary of Essex and Hertfordshire, through Hatfield Heath and”

there shall be substituted—

“south-eastwards along the A1060 road from the point where that road crosses the county boundary of Essex and Hertfordshire near Bishop’s Stortford, through Hatfield Heath to the junction with the A414 road at Writtle, thence through”

This order varies part of the boundary of an area in the county of Essex which has been specified by the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food as an area in which section 33 of the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964 has been brought into force for the protection of certain specified seed crops from injurious cross-pollination.
