The Social Security (Contributions, Re-rating) Consequential **Amendment Regulations 1979**

Made 8th January 1979 Laid before Parliament 9th January 1979 Coming into Operation 6th April 1979

The Secretary of State for Social Services in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 129(1) of the Social Security Act 1975(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, by this instrument, which contains only provisions in consequence of the Social Security (Contributions, Re-rating) Order 1978(b), for the purpose of making provision consequential on that order makes the following regulations, which accordingly are not subject to the requirement for prior reference to the National Insurance Advisory Committee(c) or to the requirement for prior Parliamentary approval(d).

Citation, interpretation and commencement

1. These regulations, which may be cited as the Social Security (Contributions, Re-rating) Consequential Amendment Regulations 1979, shall be read as one with the Social Security (Contributions) Regulations 1975(e) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") and shall come into operation on 6th April 1979.

Amendment of regulation 89(c) of the principal regulations

2. In regulation 89(c) of the principal regulations (modification in relation to share fishermen of Part I of the Act and so much of Part IV thereof as relates to contributions) for "£3.00" there shall be substituted "£3.30".
