The European Communities (Definition of Treaties) (ECSC Decision of 9th April 1979 on Supplementary Revenues) Order 1979

Whereas Her Majesty, in pursuance of the Regency Acts 1937 to 1953, was pleased, by Letters Patent dated the 16th day of July 1979, to delegate to the six Counsellors of State therein named or any two or more of them full power and authority during the period of Her Majesty's absence from the United Kingdom to summon and hold on Her Majesty's behalf Her Privy Council and to signify thereat Her Majesty's approval for anything for which Her Majesty's approval in Council is required:

And whereas a draft of this Order has been laid before Parliament in accordance with section 1 of the European Communities Act 1972(a) and has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth The Queen Mother and His Royal Highness The Prince Charles, Prince of Wales, being authorised thereto by the said Letters Patent, and in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 1(3) of the European Communities Act 1972 and all other powers enabling Her Majesty, do hereby, by and with the advice of Her Majesty's Privy Council, on Her Majesty's behalf order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the European Communities (Definition of Treaties) (ECSC Decision of 9th April 1979 on Supplementary Revenues) Order 1979. It shall come into operation on the date on which the Treaty specified in the Schedule this Order enters into force for the United Kingdom. This date will be notified in the London, Edinburgh and Belfast Gazettes.

2. The Treaty specified in the Schedule to this Order is to be regarded as a Community Treaty as defined in section 1(2) of the European Communities Act 1972.

Decision of the Representatives of the Governments of the Member States of the European Coal and Steel Community, meeting within the Council, of 9th April 1979 allocating to that Community supplementary revenues for 1979 (Cmnd. 7584).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order declares the Decision of the Representatives of the Governments of the Member States of the European Coal and Steel Community, meeting within the Council, of 9th April 1979 (Cmnd. 7584) to be a Community Treaty as defined in section 1(2) of the European Communities Act 1972. This Decision allocates to the European Coal and Steel Community supplementary revenues totalling 28 million European Units of Account for the financial year 1979.
