# The Pensioners' Lump Sum Payments Order 1980

Whereas a draft of this order was laid before Parliament and approved by resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State for Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 4(1) and (2) of the Pensioners' Payments and Social Security Act 1979(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Pensioners' Lump Sum Payments Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 1st December 1980.
- (2) In this order "the Act" means the Pensioners' Payments and Social Security Act 1979.

Substitution in the Act for references to the relevant week and to the passing of the Act

- 2. Sections 1 to 3 of the Act shall have effect as if—
  - (a) for references to the relevant week there were substituted references to the week beginning 1st December 1980; and
  - (b) for references to the passing of the Act there were substituted references to the making of this order.

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order, a draft of which has been laid before and approved by resolution of each House of Parliament, provides for a lump sum payment (Christmas bonus) to be made in respect of a person in whose case the provisions of sections 1 to 3 of the Pensioners' Payments and Social Security Act 1979 are satisfied for a day in the week beginning Monday 1st December 1980. The power in section 4(3) of the Act to provide for a larger lump sum payment than £10 not having been exercised in this Order, such payments will be of £10 as provided for in the Act.
