**The Milk (Northern Ireland) (Amendment) Order 1980**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>7th August 1980</i>
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	<i>8th August 1980</i>
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>10th August 1980</i>

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 6, 7 and 22(3) of the Emergency Laws (Re-enactments and Repeals) Act 1964(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This order may be cited as the Milk (Northern Ireland) (Amendment) Order 1980, and shall come into operation on 10th August 1980.

*Amendment of the principal order*

2. The Milk (Northern Ireland) Order 1980(b) shall be amended by substituting for Schedule 1 thereto the Schedule to this order.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This amending Order, which comes into operation on 10th August 1980, increases by  $\frac{1}{2}$ p per pint the maximum retail prices of milk on sales in Northern Ireland. There are corresponding increases in the maximum retail prices of milk sold in metric units.
