# The Milk (Northern Ireland) (Amendment) Order 1980

Made - - - 7th August 1980

Laid before Parliament 8th August 1980

Coming into Operation 10th August 1980

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 6, 7 and 22(3) of the Emergency Laws (Reenactments and Repeals) Act 1964(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

#### Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Milk (Northern Ireland) (Amendment) Order 1980, and shall come into operation on 10th August 1980.

## Amendment of the principal order

2. The Milk (Northern Ireland) Order 1980(b) shall be amended by substituting for Schedule 1 thereto the Schedule to this order.

This amending Order, which comes into operation on 10th August 1980, increases by  $\frac{1}{2}$ p per pint the maximum retail prices of milk on sales in Northern Ireland. There are corresponding increases in the maximum retail prices of milk sold in metric units.
