The Milk (Great Britain) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 1980

<i>Made</i> - - - -	28th August 1980
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	29th August 1980
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	1st September 1980

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 6 and 7 of the Emergency Laws (Re-enactments and Repeals) Act 1964(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf I hereby make the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Milk (Great Britain) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 1980, and shall come into operation on 1st September 1980.

Amendment of the principal order

2. The Milk (Great Britain) Order 1980(b) shall be further amended by substituting in Schedule 3 in the column headed “Maximum Price (Rate per Litre)” in the entry opposite the entry at (c) in the column headed “On a sale for heat treatment” for the figures ‘15·101’ the figures ‘15·584’.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This amending Order, which comes into operation on 1st September 1980, increases by 0·483p per litre the maximum price for the sale in Scotland (excluding certain islands) of raw milk for heat treatment.
