**The Milk (Great Britain) (Amendment) (No. 2)  
Order 1980**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>28th August 1980</i>
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	<i>29th August 1980</i>
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>1st September 1980</i>

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 6 and 7 of the Emergency Laws (Re-enactments and Repeals) Act 1964(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This order may be cited as the Milk (Great Britain) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1980, and shall come into operation on 1st September 1980.

*Amendment of the Milk (Great Britain) Order 1980*

2. The Milk (Great Britain) Order 1980(b) shall be further amended by substituting for the maximum prices of 14.915p specified in relation to item (a) and 15.144p specified in relation to item (b) in the table in Schedule 3 thereto the maximum prices of 14.539p and 16.176p respectively from 1st September 1980 to 30th September 1980 inclusive and the maximum prices of 13.947p and 15.584p respectively on and after 1st October 1980.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This amending Order, which comes into operation on 1st September 1980—

- (a) decreases to 14.539p per litre from 1st September 1980 to 30th September 1980 inclusive the maximum price for the sale of raw milk for heat treatment at a dairy situated within the Metropolitan Police District, for sale by retail thereafter within that district, and also decreases to 13.947p per litre that maximum price, with effect from 1st October 1980;
- (b) increases to 16.176p per litre from 1st September 1980 to 30th September 1980 inclusive the maximum price for the sale of raw milk for heat treatment at a dairy situated in England or Wales and not falling within (a) above, and decreases that maximum price to 15.584p per litre, with effect from 1st October 1980.
