## SCOTTISH LAND COURT

## The Scottish Land Court (Fees) Amendment Rules 1980

Made - - - - 22nd August 1980

Coming into Operation 15th September 1980

The Scottish Land Court, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 29 of the Crofters Holdings (Scotland) Act 1886(a), as read with section 28(1) of the Small Landholders (Scotland) Act 1911(b), and by section 3(12) of the Small Landholders (Scotland) Act 1911 and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and with the approval of the Treasury, hereby make the following rules:—

1. For the Table of Fees contained in Appendix I to the Schedule to the Scottish Land Court Rules 1979(c) there shall be substituted the Table set out in the Schedule hereto.
2. These rules may be cited on the Scottish Land Court (Fees) Amendment Rules 1980 and shall come into operation on 15th September 1980.
