LAND REGISTRATION, SCOTLAND

Land Registration (Scotland) Act 1979 (Commencement No. 1) Order 1980

Made - - - 16th September 1980

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 30(2) of the Land Registration (Scotland) Act 1979(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation and interpretation

- 1. This order may be cited as the Land Registration (Scotland) Act 1979 (Commencement No. 1) Order 1980.
- 2. In this order a reference to the Act is a reference to the Land Registration (Scotland) Act 1979.

Commencement

- 3. Subsections (1) and (2) of section 2 and subsection (3) of section 3 shall come into operation on 6th April 1981 in the area, for the purpose of registration of writs, of the County of Renfrew.
- 4. The other provisions of the Act, except those provisions which, under section 30(2) of the Act, came into operation on the passing of the Act, shall also come into operation on 6th April 1981.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into force on 6th April 1981 those provisions of the Land Registration (Scotland) Act 1979 which are not already in operation, with the exception of subsections (1) and (2) of section 2 (which subsections provide for the circumstances in which an interest in land shall be registerable) and subsection (3) of section 3 (which subsection provides that certain persons are to obtain a real right only by registration) which are to come into force only in the area of the County of Renfrew.
