POLICE

The Police (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations 1980

Made - - - - 30th September 1980

Laid before Parliament 8th October 1980

Coming into Operation 1st November 1980

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 33 of the Police Act 1964(a) and after consulting the Police Negotiating Board for the United Kingdom in accordance with section 2(1) of the Police Negotiating Board Act 1980(b), I hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations 1980.

2. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st November 1980 and shall have effect for the purposes of Regulations 4, 5, 6 and 8 as from 1st September 1980.

3. In these Regulations any reference to the principal Regulations is a reference to the Police Regulations 1979(c).

4. In Regulation 63 of the principal Regulations (London allowance) for the words “£738” there shall be substituted the words “£894”.

5. In paragraph 1 of Schedule 11 to the principal Regulations (dog handler’s allowance), as substituted by Regulation 5 of the Police (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1980(d), there shall be substituted, in sub-paragraph (1)(a), for the words “£288” the words “£348”, and in sub-paragraph (1)(b), for the words “£387” the words “£468”.

6. In paragraph 1(5) of Schedule 5 to the principal Regulations (scales of pay) the words “performing the duties he in fact performed as a chief inspector” shall be omitted.

7. Paragraph 2(3) of Schedule 5 to the principal Regulations shall be omitted.

8. In Schedule 5 to the principal Regulations for Tables A and B there shall be substituted respectively the Tables set out in the Appendix to these Regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Police Regulations 1979 with effect, as provided by Regulation 2, from the dates mentioned below (retrospection is authorised by section 33(4) of the Police Act 1964).

Regulations 4 and 5 increase, with effect from 1st September 1980, certain allowances payable to members of a police force. These allowances are the London allowance (Regulation 4), and the dog handler's allowance (Regulation 5), payable where a dog owned by the police authority is kept and cared for by a member of a police force at his home.

Regulation 6 removes, with effect from 1st September 1980, the words "performing the duties he in fact performed as a chief inspector" from paragraph 1(5) of Schedule 5 to the principal Regulations. The effect of the amendment is to allow a detective chief inspector promoted to uniformed superintendent, whose earnings in the lower rank were higher than those of an officer on the first point of the superintendent scale, to be placed on the second point of that scale.

Regulation 7, which takes effect on 1st November 1980, removes a provision which is spent.

Regulation 8 substitutes, with effect from 1st September 1980, new pay scales for those contained in Schedule 5 to the principal Regulations.
