**BETTING, GAMING AND LOTTERIES****The Amusements with Prizes (Variation of Monetary Limits) (Scotland) Order 1980**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>31st January 1980</i>
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	<i>14th February 1980</i>
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>3rd March 1980</i>

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 18(1) of the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Amusements with Prizes (Variation of Monetary Limits) (Scotland) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 3rd March 1980.

(2) This order shall extend to Scotland only.

2. Paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) of section 16(3) of the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976 (conditions on which the provision of amusements is permitted at certain commercial entertainments) shall have effect as if—

- (a) in paragraph (a), for the sum of 10p there were substituted the sum of 20p;
- (b) in paragraph (b), for the sum of £5 there were substituted the sum of £10; and
- (c) in paragraph (c), for the sum of 10p there were substituted the sum of 20p.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order increases for Scotland the maximum amounts permitted—

- (a) to be paid for any one chance;
- (b) to be taken by way of the sale of chances; and
- (c) to be offered as a money prize,

in amusements provided at certain fairs and other commercial entertainments under section 16 of the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976.
