The Common Agricultural Policy (Protection of Community Arrangements) (Amendment) Regulations 1980

Made ---16th October 1980Laid before Parliament17th October 1980Coming into operation20th October 1980

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State, being Ministers designated by the European Communities (Designation) Order 1972 (a) for the purpose of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 (b) in relation to the common agricultural policy of the European Economic Community, acting jointly in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the said section 2(2) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following regulations:—

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Common Agricultural Policy (Protection of Community Arrangements) (Amendment) Regulations 1980 and shall come into operation on 20th October1980.
- 2. In the first column of the Schedule to the Common Agricultural Policy (Protection of Community Arrangements) Regulations 1973 (c) immediately above the word "Silkworms" there shall be inserted the words "Sheepmeat and goatmeat" and opposite thereto in the second column there shall be inserted the words "Meat and edible meat offals of sheep and goats, salted, in brine, dried or smoked. Other prepared or preserved meat or meat offals containing meat or offals of sheep and goats other than those containing meat or offals of swine or bovine animals. Unrendered fats of sheep or goats; rendered or solvent-extracted fats (including "premier jus") obtained from those fats."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Common Agricultural Policy (Protection of Community Arrangements) Regulations 1973 by extending the powers provided for in those regulations, such as the requirement to keep records and the power to enter premises, for the protection of the Community support system to cover the common regime for sheepmeat and goatmeat established by Council Regulation (EEC) No. 1837 of 27th June 1980 (O. J. No. L 183, 16.7.80, p. 1.).
