# TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT The Employment Protection (Medical Suspension) Order 1980

Made - - - - 17th October 1980

Laid before Parliament 28th October 1980

Coming into Operation 18th August 1981

The Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 19(3) of the Employment Protection (Consolidation) Act 1978(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

## Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Employment Protection (Medical Suspension) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 18th August 1981.

## Interpretation

- 2. In this Order—
  - (a) "the 1978 Act" means the Employment Protection (Consolidation) Act 1978;
  - (b) "the 1976 Order" means the Employment Protection (Medical Suspension) Order 1976(b).

## Revocation and removal

- **3.**—(1) The 1976 Order is hereby revoked.
- (2) The following provisions are hereby removed from the list specified in Schedule 1 to the 1978 Act:—


# **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order, which comes into operation on 18th August 1981, removes certain provisions from, and adds other provisions to, the list of specified provisions in Schedule 1 to the Employment Protection (Consolidation) Act 1978 ("the 1978 Act").

The provisions in Schedule 1 to the 1978 Act are specified for the purposes of the right to remuneration on suspension on medical grounds under section 19 of the said Act.

The provisions added to the Schedule are the Radioactive Substances (Road Transport Workers) (Great Britain) (Amendment) Regulations 1975 and the Control of Lead at Work Regulations 1980, and the latter provision replaces the provisions removed from Schedule 1.
