HEALTH AND SAFETY

The Health and Safety (Enforcing Authority) (Amendment) Regulations 1980

Made - - - 14th November 1980

Laid before Parliament 25th November 1980

Coming into Operation 29th December 1980

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 15(1) and (3)(c) of the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974(a) ("the 1974 Act") and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and for the purpose of giving effect without modifications to proposals submitted to him by the Health and Safety Commission under section 11(2)(d) of the 1974 Act after the carrying out by the said Commission of consultations in accordance with section 50(3) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Health and Safety (Enforcing Authority) (Amendment) Regulations 1980 and shall come into operation on 29th December 1980.

Amendment

2. In Schedule 1 to the Health and Safety (Enforcing Authority) Regulations 1977(b) in paragraph 5 after the word "repairs" there shall be inserted the words "or the maintenance or repair of motor vehicles".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend Part I of Schedule 1 to the Health and Safety (Enforcing Authority) Regulations 1977 (which specifies those main activities for which local authorities are responsible for enforcing the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974 and other relevant statutory provisions) by excluding from those activities the maintenance or repair of motor vehicles, the enforcing authority for which shall be the Health and Safety Executive.
