**LOCAL GOVERNMENT, ENGLAND AND WALES**  
**The County of Cheshire (Electoral Arrangements) Order 1980**

*Made - - - - 26th November 1980*

*Coming into operation in accordance with Article 2*

Whereas in pursuance of section 51(1) of the Local Government Act 1972<sup>(a)</sup>, the Local Government Boundary Commission for England on 1st August 1980 submitted proposals for the future electoral arrangements for the County of Cheshire:

And whereas in giving effect to those proposals I have decided to make certain modifications:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred upon me by sections 51(2) and 67 of the said Act, I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the County of Cheshire (Electoral Arrangements) Order 1980.

2. This Order shall come into operation on 7th May 1981 provided that for the purpose of all proceedings preliminary or relating to an election to be held on or after that day the said Order shall come into operation forthwith.

3.—(1) The existing electoral divisions of the County of Cheshire shall be abolished and the said county shall be divided into seventy-one electoral divisions which shall bear the names set out in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order, and each such electoral division shall comprise the existing areas specified opposite thereto in column 2 of the said Schedule.

(2) The number of councillors to be elected for each electoral division constituted by this Order shall be one.

4. Where a boundary is described in the Schedule to this Order as running along a road, railway line, footway, waterway or other similar geographical feature, it shall be treated as running along the centre line thereof.

5. The ordinary elections of all councillors for the County of Cheshire shall be held simultaneously on the ordinary day of election of county councillors in 1981 and every fourth year thereafter.

6. Each registration officer shall make such re-arrangement or alteration of the register of local government electors as may be necessary on account of the coming into operation of this Order.
