The Minister of Transport in exercise of the powers conferred by section 50(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1972(a), and now vested in him(b), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with the provisions of section 199(2) of the said Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Type Approval) (Great Britain) (Fees) Regulations 1980 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1980.

Revocation

2. The Regulations specified in Schedule 4 are hereby revoked.

Interpretation

- 3.—(1) In these Regulations, except where the context otherwise requires:— "the Act" means the Road Traffic Act 1972;
 - "Community Directive" means a Council or Commission Directive concerning the approximation of laws of member States of the European Community for the purpose of the type approval of motor vehicles and trailers and their components, being a Directive mentioned in Schedule 1:
 - "Community Regulation" means a Council Regulation concerning the harmonisation of certain social legislation relating to road transport, being a Regulation mentioned in Schedule 1:
 - "ECE Regulation" means a Regulation annexed to the Agreement concerning the adoption of uniform conditions of approval for motor vehicle equipment and parts and reciprocal recognition thereof concluded at Geneva on 20th March 1958(a) being a Regulation mentioned in Schedule 1;
 - "examination", in relation to a vehicle or vehicle part, includes any test or series of tests required to be carried out for the purposes of the national type approval scheme;
 - "Government or approved premises" means premises established or approved by the Minister of Transport for the examination of vehicles or vehicle parts for the purpose of the national type approval scheme or the scheme for the type approval of vehicles and vehicle parts provided for in the Motor Vehicles (Type Approval) Regulations 1973(b);
 - "the Great Britain Regulations" means the Motor Vehicles (Type Approval) (Great Britain) Regulations 1979(c);
 - "the issue of a type approval certificate or Minister's approval certificate" includes the issue of a modified or duplicate certificate;
 - "the national type approval scheme" means the scheme for the type approval of vehicles and vehicle parts provided for in sections 47 to 52 of the Act and in the Great Britain Regulations;
 - "type approval requirement" means a type approval requirement prescribed by the Great Britain Regulations.
- (2) Unless the context otherwise requires, any reference in these Regulations to-
 - (a) a numbered Regulation or Schedule is a reference to the Regulation of or Schedule to these Regulations bearing that number;
 - (b) a numbered paragraph is a reference to the paragraph bearing that number in the Regulation or Schedule in which that number appears.

Fees—Basic scale for examinations

4. Subject to the provisions of these Regulations, the fee to be paid for the carrying out, or supervision, by or on behalf of the Minister of Transport of an examination of a vehicle or vehicle part in connection with the issue of a type approval certificate or Minister's approval certificate for the purpose of the national type approval scheme shall be, for the type approval requirements listed in column (2) of Schedule 1, a fee of the amount specified—

- (a) in column (4)(a) of Schedule 1, where the test is to be carried out on Government or approved premises by an officer of the Department of Transport or a person appointed by the Minister of Transport to act on his behalf, or
- (b) in column (4)(b) of Schedule 1, where the test is to be carried out at other premises under the supervision of an officer of the Department of Transport or a person appointed by the Minister of Transport to act on his behalf,

in relation to the particular type approval requirement specified in column (2) of Schedule 1 or, where more than one type of examination or more than one type of vehicle or vehicle part is specified in column (3) of Schedule 1 in connection with the same type approval requirement, in relation to the particular type of examination, vehicle or vehicle part in question.

Fees—Consecutive examinations

5. Where more than one vehicle or vehicle part of the same type but embodying minor variations are submitted by one applicant with a view to carrying out the examinations consecutively on each item and the case is one where all the examinations can be carried out without setting up the testing apparatus again, the fee to be paid for the carrying out of each examination after the first one shall be such proportion of the relevant sum specified in Schedule 1 as is appropriate in view of the work involved in carrying out such examination.

Fees—Partial examinations

- 6.—(1) Where, in consequence of an alteration in the design specification of a vehicle or vehicle part in relation to which a type approval certificate or a Minister's approval certificate has been issued for the purpose of the national type approval scheme, in connection with a type approval requirement specified in column (2) of Schedule 1, a further examination of the vehicle or vehicle part is needed with a view to the issue of a modified or further certificate, but the alteration is not so extensive as to require that the further examination shall be as complete and exhaustive as the original examination, the fee to be paid for the carrying out of the further examination shall be such proportion of the relevant sum specified in Schedule 1 as is appropriate in view of the nature and extent of the further examination.
- (2) Where, in consequence of an alteration in the design specification of a vehicle or vehicle part in relation to which a type approval certificate or a Minister's approval certificate has been issued for the purpose of the national type approval scheme, an applicant requests a certificate modifying an approval certificate but the alteration is not so extensive as to require a further examination of the vehicle or vehicle part and can be carried out on an examination of data supplied by the applicant, the fee for such an examination shall be such proportion of the fee prescribed in Regulation 4 as is appropriate in view of the nature and extent of the examination.
- (3) Where, in the case of any such examination as is mentioned in Regulation 4 or 5 or in paragraph (1) or (2)—
 - (a) it has been found impossible to complete the examination satisfactorily, or

(b) the vehicle or vehicle part submitted for the examination does not satisfy completely the requirements of the examination,

and in consequence a further, but partial, examination of the vehicle or vehicle part is required, the fee to be paid for such further examination shall be such proportion of the relevant sum specified in Schedule 1 as is appropriate in view of the nature and extent of the further, but partial, examination.

(4) Where more than one vehicle or vehicle part of the same type but embodying minor variations are submitted by one applicant and it is unnecessary to submit each individual vehicle or vehicle part to a complete examination, the fee to be paid for the carrying out of the partial examination on a particular vehicle or vehicle part shall be such proportion of the relevant sum specified in Schedule 1 as is appropriate in view of the nature and extent of the partial examination.

Fees—Final examination of complete vehicle

- 7.—(1) The fee for the final examination of a complete vehicle with a view to the issue in respect of that vehicle of a document specified in column (2) of Schedule 2 where, before the examination takes place, type approval procedures have been carried out (whether in Great Britain or elsewhere) to ascertain that in respect of that vehicle all the type approval requirements which—
 - (a) are referred to in Schedule 1, and
 - (b) relate to particular parts or aspects of a vehicle, and
 - (c) are applicable to the vehicle,

have been satisfied shall be of the amount specified in column (3) of Schedule 2.

- (2) Where, in the case of an examination of a complete vehicle mentioned in paragraph (1)—
 - (a) it has been found impossible to complete that examination satisfactorily, or
 - (b) the vehicle has been found not to comply in all respects with the relevant type approval requirements, or
 - (c) the vehicle is one which has been assembled in more than one stage by more than one manufacturer, or
 - (d) a type approval certificate or Minister's approval certificate has previously been issued in respect of the model of the vehicle but the vehicle incorporates certain changes in detail not covered by that certificate,

and, in consequence, a further, but partial, examination of the vehicle is required before the relevant document can properly be issued in respect of it, the fee for that partial examination shall be such proportion of the relevant sum specified in Schedule 2 as is appropriate in view of the nature and extent of the partial examination.

Fees—Avoidance of duplication

8. Where the examination of a vehicle or vehicle part for the purposes of the national type approval scheme is carried out at the same time as the test of

that vehicle or vehicle part for the purposes of a Community Directive, Community Regulation or ECE Regulation then, in so far as one and the same operation or series of operations serves for the purpose of both the examination and the test, the fee payable under these Regulations for the carrying out, or supervision, of the examination shall be adjusted, as necessary, so as to secure that only one sum is paid under these Regulations and the Motor Vehicles (Type Approval and Approval Marks) (Fees) Regulations 1980(a) for that operation or series of operations.

Fees—Issue of documents

9. The fee for the issue of a document of a type specified in column (2) of Schedule 3 shall be a fee of the amount specified in relation thereto in column (3) of Schedule 3.

Payment of fees

- 10.—(1) The fee for the carrying out, or supervision, of an examination of a vehicle or vehicle part shall be paid when the applicant is notified by the Minister of Transport in accordance with the provisions of the Great Britain Regulations of the fee payable, and the amount to be paid shall be the amount prescribed by Regulation 4 and (where applicable) 5, 6, 7 or 8.
- (2) The fee for the issue of a document specified in Schedule 2 or 3 shall be paid—
 - (a) in a case where the examination of a vehicle or vehicle part for which a fee is payable under these Regulations is required before the document is issued, when the applicant is notified of the result of the examination, and
 - (b) in any other case, when the application is made for the issue of the document.

Fees on withdrawals and cancellations

- 11.—(1) Subject to Regulation 12, if the applicant for the issue of a type approval certificate or Minister's approval certificate for a vehicle-or vehicle part—
 - (a) after he has been notified of the time and place for the examination withdraws his application, or
 - (b) does not submit the vehicle or vehicle part for the examination at the time and place fixed therefor,

he shall be liable to pay a cancellation fee to cover the abortive work involved in dealing with the application and making arrangements for the examination—

- (i) of £50 if the Minister of Transport is notified of the withdrawal or of the intention not to submit the vehicle for the examination not less than 7 days before the date fixed for the examination, or
- (ii) of £100 where the fee for the proposed examination is £200 or more, or one half of the relevant fee where that is less than £200, in any other case.

- (2) Any cancellation fee for which an applicant is liable in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (1) shall be provided—
 - (a) in a case where the applicant has paid the fee prescribed by these Regulations for the examination in question, by the Minister of Transport retaining the said cancellation fee from the fee which has been paid, or
 - (b) in any other case by the applicant paying the said cancellation fee to the Minister of Transport within 14 days of the issue by the Minister of Transport of a request for such payment.
- (3) If an appointment for the examination of a vehicle is cancelled at the instance of the Minister of Transport after the appropriate fee has been paid, and no alternative appointment, acceptable to the applicant, is offered to him, the whole of the fee paid by the applicant shall be refunded to him.
- (4) Where a refund has been made under paragraph (3) to an applicant who has not withdrawn his application, he shall pay the appropriate fee prescribed by these Regulations when he is notified of a new appointment for the examination of the vehicle in question.

Submission of alternative vehicle or vehicle part for examination

12. Where an applicant for the issue of a type approval certificate or Minister's approval certificate for a vehicle or vehicle part does not wish, or is unable, to submit that vehicle or vehicle part for examination at the time and place appointed, but is able to submit for examination at that time and place some other vehicle or vehicle part which can conveniently be fitted into the programme of examinations being carried out at that place and in respect of which he has made an application for such certificate he shall be entitled, subject to any adjustment by way of refund or additional payment so as to secure that the appropriate fee is paid for the examination which actually takes place, to have the sum which he originally paid applied in payment of the fee for that examination without being liable to pay a cancellation fee under Regulation 11(1), but in that event he shall pay the appropriate fee prescribed by these Regulations when applying for a new appointment for the examination which he originally sought.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

- 1. These Regulations consolidate, with amendments, the provisions of the Motor Vehicles (Type Approval)(Great Britain)(Fees) Regulations 1976 and the amending Regulations specified in Schedule 4 and revoked by Regulation 2.
- 2. These Regulations prescribe the fees payable for the examination of vehicles and vehicle parts, and for the issue of documents, in connection with the national scheme for the type approval of vehicles and vehicle parts established under sections 47 to 52 of the Road Traffic Act 1972 (as amended by the Road Traffic Act 1974) and the Motor Vehicles (Type Approval) (Great Britain) Regulations 1979.
- 3. The basic scale of fees for examinations is fixed by Regulations 4 and 7 and Schedules 1 and 2. Provision is made in Regulations 5, 6 and 8 for adjustments to the fees payable in certain circumstances.
- 4. The fees for the issue of documents are prescribed by Regulation 9 and Schedule 3.
- 5. Regulation 10 indicates when the fees are to be paid. Regulation 11 provides for the payment, in certain circumstances, of a cancellation charge in cases where an application for a type approval certificate or Minister's approval certificate is withdrawn. Regulation 12 provides for the situation where an alternative vehicle or vehicle part is submitted for examination.
- 6. The main amendments to the provisions of the Regulations of 1976 provide for:—
 - (a) a partial fee to be charged where a minor design change necessitates a modification to an approval, but the modification can be considered without a further examination;
 - (b) a partial fee to be charged in cases where a vehicle or vehicle part has failed to satisfy the requirements of the examination or it has been found impossible to complete the examination satisfactorily and a partial re-examination is carried out utilising data gathered at the earlier abortive examination;
 - (c) the payment by the applicant of a cancellation charge if the application for an examination is withdrawn;
 - (d) revised Schedules of fees for the examination of vehicles or vehicle parts (Schedule 1), for the final examination of complete vehicles (Schedule 2), and for the issue of documents (Schedule 3).
 - 7. In the revised Schedule 1, the main changes are as follows:—
 - (a) the references to the particulars of the type of examination, vehicle or vehicle part in column (3) have been amended in the entries relating to fees, numbers 15/1, 17/1, 61, 62, 64 and 64/1;
 - (b) the following fees are altered:—
 - (In Schedule 1 to these Regulations, and in this Note, the charges shown in column (a) apply where the examination is carried out on Government or approved premises; the charges shown in column (b) apply where the examination is carried out at other premises.)
