

1980 No. 457**HIGHWAYS, ENGLAND AND WALES****The New Street Byelaws
(Extension of Operation) Order 1980***Made - - - - 27th March 1980*

The Secretary of State for the Environment, as respects England, and the Secretary of State for Wales, as respects Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 312(6) of the Highways Act 1959(a), and now vested in them (b), and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the New Street Byelaws (Extension of Operation) Order 1980.

2. Any byelaws which have been continued in force by virtue of the New Street Byelaws (Extension of Operation) Orders 1962(c), 1967(d), 1972(e), 1974(f) and 1977(g) and which are in force on 31st March 1980 shall remain in force until 31st March 1983 or until they are revoked, whichever date is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order extends until 31st March 1983 the period of operation of certain new street byelaws which were made before the coming into operation of the Highways Act 1959 under enactments which were repealed by that Act. Section 312(6) of that Act continued those byelaws in operation until 31st December 1962 and subsequent orders under that subsection have further continued their period of operation until 31st March 1980.
