## **SEEDS**

# The Seed Potatoes (Fees) Regulations 1980

Made -2nd April 1980

Laid before Parliament 14th April 1980

Coming into Operation 5th May 1980

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food in relation to England and the Secretary of State for Wales in relation to Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16(1), (1A)(e) and (5)(a) of the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964(a), and now vested in them(b), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, after consultation with representatives of such interests as appear to them to be concerned, hereby make the following Regulations:—

#### Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Seed Potatoes (Fees) Regulations 1980 and shall come into operation on 5th May 1980.

## Revocation of previous regulations

2. The Seed Potatoes (Fees) Regulations 1979(c) are hereby revoked.

#### Fees

- 3. There shall be paid in advance in respect of matters arising under the Seed Potatoes Regulations 1978(d) referred to in the Schedule hereto or under any regulations amending or superseding them the fees respectively specified in the second column of the said Schedule opposite the references to such matters.
- 4. The said fees shall be payable to the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (hereinafter referred to as "The Minister").
- 5. The Minister may exempt any person or class of persons or persons generally from compliance in whole or in part with the provisions of these Regulations in relation to payment of fees and any exemptions so made may be made subject to conditions.
