**The Legal Aid in Criminal Proceedings (General)
 (Amendment) Regulations 1980**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 39 of the Legal Aid Act 1974(a), I hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Legal Aid in Criminal Proceedings (General) (Amendment) Regulations 1980 and shall come into operation on 23rd June 1980.

2. In Regulation 26 (disposal of sums received from legally assisted persons after conviction) of the Legal Aid in Criminal Proceedings (General) Regulations 1968(b) for the words “paragraphs (a) and (b) above” there shall be substituted the words “paragraph (2) below”.
