CROWN AGENTS FOR OVERSEA GOVERNMENTS AND ADMINISTRATIONS

The Crown Agents (Additional Powers) Order 1980

Made - - - - 9th May 1980Laid before Parliament28th May 1980Coming into Operation17th June 1980

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 4(3) of the Crown Agents Act 1979(a) and Article 2(1) of the Ministry of Overseas Development (Dissolution) Order 1979(b), hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Crown Agents (Additional Powers) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 17th June 1980.
- 2.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) below, the Crown Agents shall have power, as agents of any scheduled authority or body, to carry on anywhere in the world the activity of making arrangements for or in connection with the insurance of any person or property by any person carrying on insurance business.
- (2) The Crown Agents shall not make any such arrangements as are specified in paragraph (1) above with any person carrying on business in the United Kingdom except—
 - (a) a person for the time being registered as an insurance broker under section 3 of the Insurance Brokers (Registration) Act 1977(c);
 - (b) a body corporate for the time being enrolled under section 4 of the Insurance Brokers (Registration) Act 1977 on the list of bodies corporate carrying on business as insurance brokers; or
 - (c) a person for the time being permitted to carry on insurance business under section 2 of the Insurance Companies Act 1974(d) or under Article 6 of the Insurance Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1976(e).
