## The Rules of Procedure (Army) (Amendment) Rules 1981

### Citation and commencement

1. These Rules may be cited as the Rules of Procedure (Army) (Amendment) Rules 1981 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1981.

#### Amendment

2. The Rules of Procedure (Army) 1972(b) as amended(c) shall be further amended in the manner and to the extent prescribed in the Schedule to these Rules.





- 5. In Appendix 2 to Schedule 9 under the heading "OFFENDER 17 OR OVER BUT UNDER 21" in the paragraph dealing with a custodial order, after "Army Act 1955", there shall be inserted "for a maximum period of ......".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Rules.)

These Rules further amend the Rules of Procedure (Army) 1972 ("the Principal Rules"). They are for the most part consequential upon the passing of the Reserve Forces Act 1980. The amendments themselves are contained in the Schedule to the Rules.

Paragraph 2 amends Part (1) of Schedule 2 of the Principal Rules, relating to commencement of charge-sheets and is consequential upon the passing of the Reserve Forces Act 1980.

Paragraph 3 amends Part (2) of Schedule 2 of the Principal Rules, relating to statements of offences and is also consequential upon the passing of the Reserve Forces Act 1980.

The remaining provisions are minor and drafting amendments.
