# The Haverfordwest-Milford Haven Trunk Road (Johnston Railway Bridge) Order 1981

Made - - - 6th August 1981

Coming into Operation 4th September 1981

The Secretary of State for Wales makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by section 10 of the Highways Act 1980(a), and of all other enabling powers:—

1. The length of trunk road described in the schedule to this Order and shown by broad striped hatching on the deposited plan shall cease to be a trunk road.

#### 2. In this Order:

"the deposited plan" means the plan numbered HA7/2—WO201 marked "The Haverfordwest-Milford Haven Trunk Road (Johnston Railway Bridge) Order 1981", signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Welsh Office, Curran Embankment Depository, Curran Embankment, Cardiff, where it may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours;

"the trunk road" means the Haverfordwest-Milford Haven trunk road (A4076).

3. This Order shall come into operation on the 4th September 1981 and may be cited as the Haverfordwest-Milford Haven Trunk Road (Johnston Railway Bridge) Order 1981.
